Luke 8:22-25 Jesus Doing What Only God Can Do

A Reminder of the Message from Sunday Luke 8:4-21

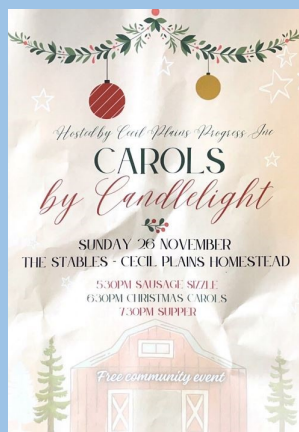
More important than the 'numbers' of people attending a church is the measure of faith, obedience and 'endurance through to the harvest' found in the believers of Jesus. And the Parable of the Sower is about how we can be fully effective in our lives as Christians. It's about learning to be the people that Jesus has saved us to be.

The whole intent of sowing a seed is to see that seed grow to produce a harvest—getting the seed through to completion. The Parable of the Sower is about becoming and being what Jesus has saved us to be—hearers and doers of God's word. We are to cling to Jesus (endure) and cling to His Word right through to the end.

In the explanation about the soil types, it is all about how we HEAR and what we Do with what we hear,

In the parable, the seed is the word of God and the soil types are different types of people—people who HEAR the Word of God and the responses that they give.

1. The seed that falls along the path—represents people who HEAR the Word of God but despise it—they disregard it and feel it has no value to them. When that decision is made, the Devil snatches the Word away.
2. The soil on the rock—represents people who HEAR the Word of God but as soon as they experience the cost of discipleship (times of testing or persecution) they fall away. When people decide that the cost is too high, the Devil snatches the Word away.
3. The seed amongst the thorns—represents people who HEAR the Word of God but refuse to repent of sin. Sin flourishes and chokes out seeds of faith. The Devil snatches the Word away.
4. Good soil—represents people who HEAR the Word of God, receive the Word of God, hold fast to the Word of God, have hearts truly submitted to God and patiently endures until harvest! God has planted the seed in our hearts with the express intent for us to grow (endure) through to the harvest!
